We are certified Napa Green at our Rutherford winery. All six of our estate vineyards are certified Fish Friendly Farming, as part of our ongoing commitment to sustainability.

DESSERT WINE

Delicias is inspired by the acclaimed port styles developed in Portugal. These sweet, fortified wines are billed as dessert wines thanks to their rich flavor and slow-sipping vibes. PEJU Winemaker Sara Fowler stops fermentation of select Zinfandel blocks when they reach approximately 12 brix; at that point she adds Brandy to help halt fermentation. Various vintages of Zinfandel are blended together to barrel age, and some portions of the blend are aged up to 10 years! Serve this wine in two-to-three ounce pours at just below room temperature. Port-style wines are great to pair with food, as they can stand up to bold flavors. A classic companion is chocolate, but any rich dessert will bring out the best in this wine.

TASTING

This utterly decadent dessert wine features vibrant notes of fresh mission figs, black raspberry, vanilla, and a hints of green and white peppercorn spice. The front of the palate is lush showcasing darker flavors of currant, plum, and hints of caramel with a bright finish. The mix of acidity and fruit makes for a balanced and sweet dessert wine.
