INSPIRATION

In honor of our rich heritage, we present the Nostalgia Series, a line of Peju Wine Club exclusive offerings. Spearheaded by Herta Peju, each label showcases a beloved photo of our property over the ages. The Farm pays homage to our Persephone Estate in Pope Valley, located in the north eastern region of Napa Valley. After sourcing Cabernet Franc from a Pope Valley vineyard, Tony was so intrigued by the region that when he saw a property for sale down the road, he purchased what is now our Persephone Estate Vineyard in 1996.

VINTAGE

February saw abundant rains, followed by lots of filtered light in spring and early summer. Both bud break and flowering occurred under ideal weather conditions, creating plentiful and even fruit set. The relatively mild summer followed by extended Fall sunshine and moderate heat created near-ideal conditions for fruit to accumulate flavor complexity.

TASTING

This Sangiovese, Cabernet Sauvignon blend sets the stage as a wine to be shared with friends and family. Bright red fruit abounds on the nose and in the glass with a dusting of cocoa powder and baking spice. Fresh juicy plum enters the palate of this medium bodied wine and is backed by a touch of earthiness. Integrated and plush tannins balance out the finish.
