VINTAGE

The beginning of the 2019 growing season was defined by an abundance of rainfall and late season soil moisture. The long, relatively mild finish to the season helped to preserve freshness and finesse in the fruit with abundant hang time teasing out great color, structure, and generous tannins. All in all, exceptional fruit with bright acidity and ample texture promises an amazing vintage.



TASTING

Heady notes of Santa Rosa plum, blueberry, and spiced vanilla flow across the palate with layers of fruit and spice. The juicy flavors are complemented by well-structured tannins and hints of savory green olives. Fantastic weight captivates while leading to a complex finish.
