INSPIRATION

The Farm pays homage to our Persephone Estate in Pope Valley, located in the northeastern region of Napa Valley. After sourcing Cabernet Franc from Pope Valley, Tony was so intrigued by the region that when he saw a property for sale in 1996, he purchased what has now become our Persephone Estate Vineyard.

VINTAGE

The beginning of the 2019 growing season was defined by an abundance of rainfall and late season soil moisture. The long, relatively mild finish to the season helped to preserve freshness and finesse in the fruit with abundant hang time teasing out great color, structure, and generous tannins. All in all, exceptional fruit with bright acidity and ample texture promises an amazing vintage.

TASTING

Inspired by Super Tuscan blends crafted in Italy, Winemaker Sara Fowler sought to make a special blend with our estate grown Sangiovese and Cabernet Sauvignon. This wine reveals lush aromas of blueberry, cranberry, and chocolate. The palate is full and bright with rich layers. Hints of cedar and suede appear on this finish providing depth to the wine. Quaffable and bright, this wine is excellent to pair with hearty Italian fare.
