After 5 years of living in Napa Valley Tony Peju wanted to create a wine that would be considered a “bridge wine”, for white wine drinkers who were ready to explore the world of red wines. Tony would bring home wines to blend at the kitchen table after long days at the winery. In 1987 Tony mastered the blend for Province, a balanced blend of red and white wine that is delicious chilled. Since then Province has

become an iconic wine in the PEJU lineup, and is adored by many.

TASTING

PEJU Province is a red and white blend which features stainless steel fermented white varietals and barrel aged red varietals. Best served chilled, this fresh blend showcases notes of tart strawberry rhubarb pie, hibiscus, and fresh raspberry. Characterics of key lime zest leave the palate with a fresh acidity that balances perfectly with its soft, fruity flavors. This wine is an ideal match for spicy foods, light meals, and can be enjoyed year-round!
